From the author: "The[se designs] could have been worn by me, my brother, and my sisters half a century ago; they could have been worn by my daughters a generation ago; my grandchildren are wearing them today; and I trust that these patterns will still be useful 20 and 50 years from now. I've used basic techniques and presented each sweater in a wide range of sizes to fit children from the end of toddlerhood through late childhood. Included are pullovers, vests, and cardigans to suit the tastes of both girls and boys. There are both top-down and bottom-up architectures, with modified T, raglan, saddle shoulder, and set-in sleeves; all with minimized sewing. These basics will prove to be useful in any child's wardrobe, and, because they are timeless, they can be handed down from child to child for many years."
